
WHAT IS 400 TREES GLOUCESTER?

HOW WE WORK

- The City of Gloucester has committed to planting 200 trees in our parks, forests, and public spaces.
- Cape Ann Elms and Biomimicry New England have each committed to giving away 100 free trees to willing Gloucester residents.
- Biomimicry New England will host tree planting and maintenance training sessions to build a cohort of citizen tree stewards.
- Biomimicry New England will partner with the Sawyer Free Library and local schools to develop a 400 Trees Gloucester curriculum for youth to be hosted at youth organizations and schools.
